The aim of this project is to install FIXIT stations at several, high bicycle traffic sites throughout campus. A FIXIT kit facilitates on-the-spot bike repairs, provides all the tools necessary to perform basic bike maintenance, from fixing a flat tire to adjusting brakes and derailleurs.

Not a mechanic? Each FIXIT station has a Quick Read (QR) code affixed to the front, which provides detailed “how-to” instructions on your smart phone. Still clueless? The grant establishes a student educator position, who will teach workshops designed for new and experienced cyclists alike!
