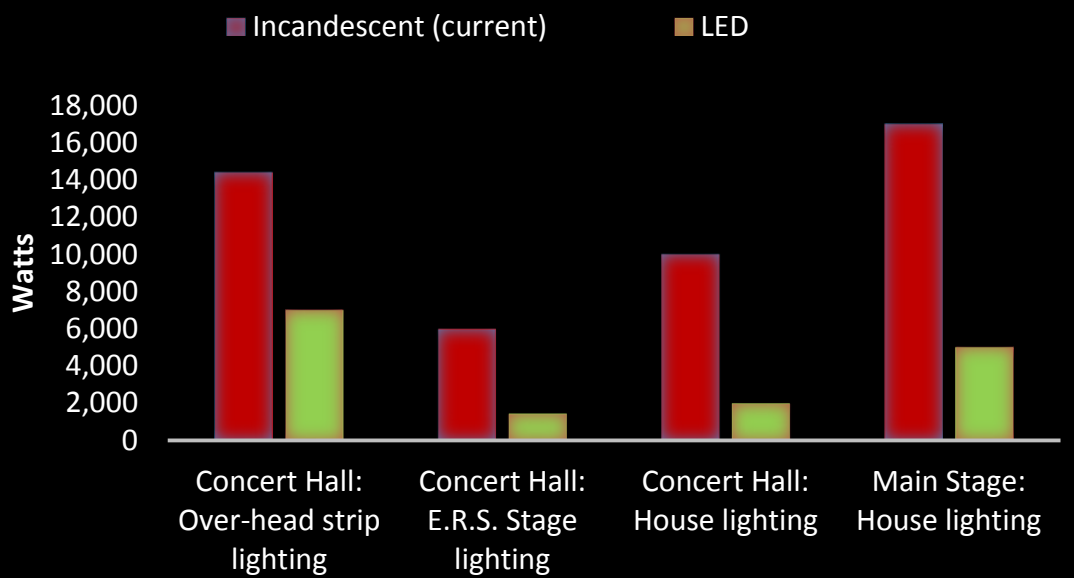

What are LEDs?

LED stands for Light Emitting Diodes. They are semi-conductor devices that produce visible light when an electrical current is passed through them.

What are the benefits of LEDs?

- Energy efficient (see chart above)
- Cost-effective
- Color options
- Durable (they do not have fragile filaments, and they are solid)
- Long-lasting
- Cool (they produce far less heat than incandescent lights)
